Who was your first ~~other~~ second teacher in Georgia City? I have ask Clara (Hadd) Smith who the teachers were in those years after 1914 - and ask Ollie Brown and Bertha Shaefer - the same questions. Maybe some day I'll get the answers - Clara has another picture of the Georgia City school, where there were only 9 students when that picture was taken. I will come maybe in June - when I have money to get all the pictures reprinted - April and May - I have insurances and other bill - Insurances that will not come up for another year - so I'm happy to get the school picture reprinted and a neg. and the two pictures of Oscar & I, will send the neg and reprints to Naomi - She will return them before long then I'll send them to you so you can see them and maybe get a reprint from the neg - I want to get the neg. passed around for all the rest of my children to get a copy - It cost me \$3.98. for the neg & reprint of the school picture and neg & reprint of Oscar & I = \$8.13 - so I'll take the easy way out & let each of my kids get their own if they want one. I have 14 photo-albums all full - so I've used a lot of money to try to give all the children and others - a history of our family in Photoes

I have a neg. of Georgia City school in 1914 -
Steve & Everett and Hamon - Manda & I are in it,
But the end where Steve & Everett are is not too
clear - I'd give my eye-teeth if I could find one
clear of that particular year - A lot of my photos
were damaged one time and a lot were lost
in a box of articles I treasured so much was
was stolen alone with a table lamp from
Virgil & Shirley - one year - also mom's green & white
quilt top you sent to me years ago - Mom had
pieced it and I was working constantly 'had no
time to finish it. There were so many things I
missed that year - some times I kick my self
for being so anxious to find out how grandpa
was put through, of course, along with thousands of
other men & boy in Civil War. but I just read a book
Gens for Waite - one of the men who fought with
the men in the mounted Indian Brigade in 62 -
(Gens for Waite) is in your library to imagine.
I hope you can read it, and also I do a lot of things
I'd like to ^{have} my children know about our begining
in life. I realize that our lives are not guaranteed
for a long life, yet I feel I must leave a heritage of our
Roots, now when you send the pictures I sent you
I'll get some neg of them I hope - You are so cute, that
we're time I look at you in this group I'm sending today
I just want to take you in my arms & squeeze you -
look, you are standing with your toes together
by now - I love you bud!
